Columbus Fire Response Fire Hydrants Smoke Detectors

Yesterday was an extremely busy day for the Columbus Division of Fire. We responded to 477 runs 334 EMS responses with four working fires. We anticipate that our responses will continue to be higher than normal due to the snow and icy conditions.

Hydrants-Columbus Fire is encouraging people in the City of Columbus area and Franklin County to assist their fire departments by clearing away snow and ice away from hydrants in front of their property. This will greatly assist us in case a fire occurs in your neighborhood.
